In the Fall 2010, the NH Broadband Mapping Program partners (NHBMP) will be conducting a series of public broadband forums around the state. The forums will support the Program’s ongoing efforts to inventory and map current and planned broadband coverage in NH. All local/regional residents, businesses, institutions, and municipalities who are interested in learning more about high speed internet access in New Hampshire and the NHBMP are encouraged to attend.

During the sessions, participants will engage in an interactive mapping session that will help to identify gaps and/or inadequacies in current broadband services. This information will help us to verify the data we are mapping, and will be instrumental in guiding future broadband planning activities.

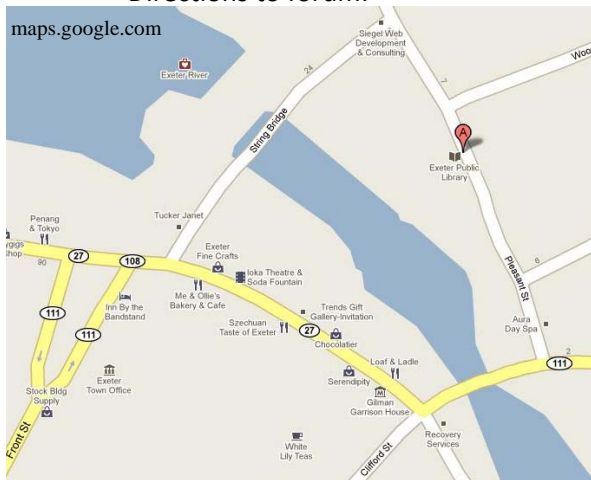
Who should attend?

Directions to Exeter Public Library
Exeter Library located at 4 Chestnut St. in Exeter, NH, 03833.

From the WEST

Route 101 East. Take Exit 10 (Route 85) Newfields Road. At the end of ramp, turn right onto Route 85 South. Follow to the end of Route 85. Turn left onto Water Street (Route 27). Follow to stop sign at Bandstand in the center of Exeter. Take first left onto String Bridge Street. Cross String Bridge St. The Library and Library parking lot are on the right. The Library is a brick building.

From the NORTH, SOUTH or EAST

Route 95 to Exit 2 (Route 101 Exeter/Hampton) Take 101 West. Take Exit 11 (Route 108) Portsmouth Avenue. Bear left at the end of ramp, onto Route 108. Follow to Route 111/108 (High Street). Turn right onto Route 111/108. Take 2nd right onto Pleasant Street. Take 1st left onto String Bridge Street. The Library and Library parking lot are on the left. The Library is a brick building.
