PROGRAM: The program will begin with essential information about how to create a town energy committee that will meet your community's needs over the long term, then move to short concurrent sessions on specific themes and project ideas. The content of each workshop will vary, but likely topics include:

- Success stories from around the state
- Organizing and sustaining an energy committee
- Energy baseline calculations
- Fundraising for committee activities
- High performance building standards (LEED)
- Energy efficiency measures for homes and municipal buildings
- The utilities' energy-saving programs
- Clean power opportunities
