SUBJECT: **Nominating Committee Report: Proposed Officer Slate/Executive Committee for FY 2004**

Per Article V, Section 2 of the Commission Bylaws, this report has been distributed to the Commission 30 days or more prior to the Annual Meeting which is scheduled for June 9, 2004.

The Nominating Committee solicited interest from the general membership at the April 24 Commission meeting and met on May 5th 2003 to consider nominations for Officers and Executive Committee members for FY 2005. The committee reviewed potential candidates, bylaw requirements and reaffirmed the general objective of officers succeeding from Secretary, to Vice Chair and then to Chair. We also reaffirmed last year's decision to leave Treasurer position out of the general succession to allow more time for that Officer to become thoroughly familiar with the agency financial management and reporting systems.
