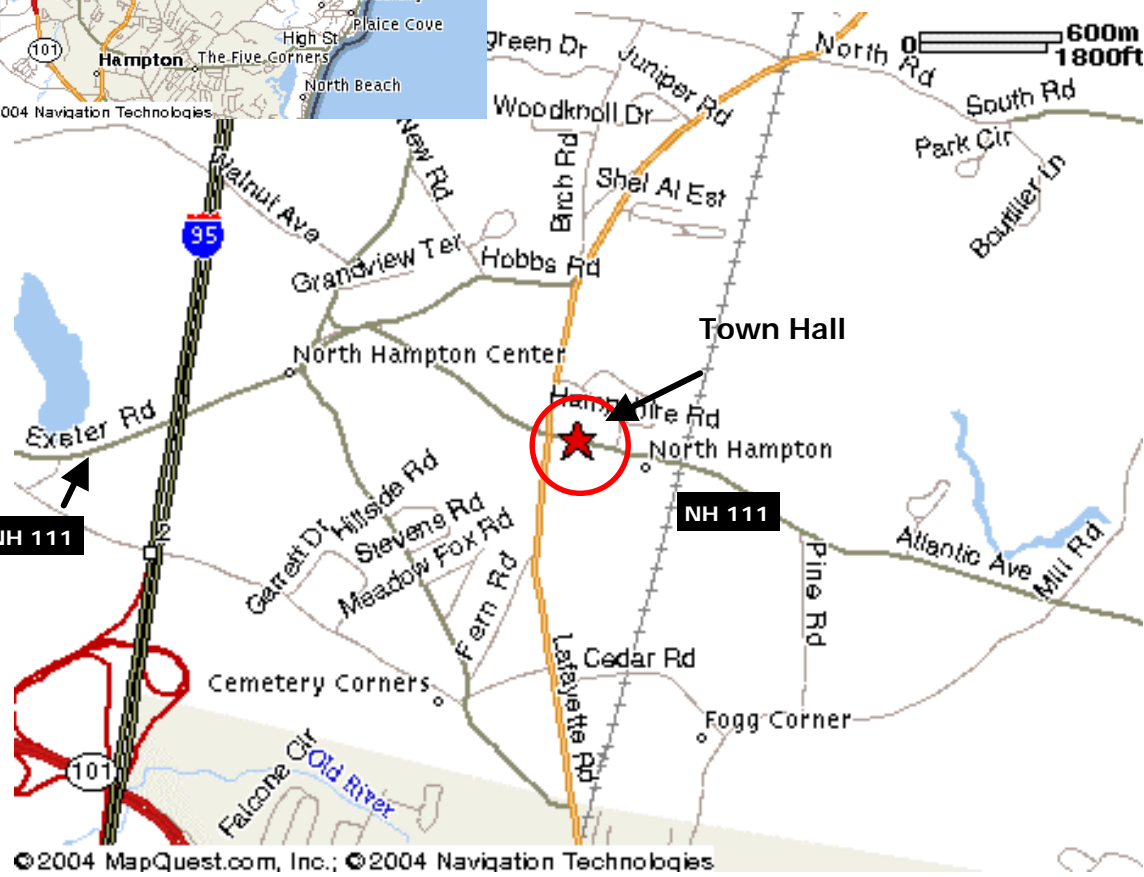
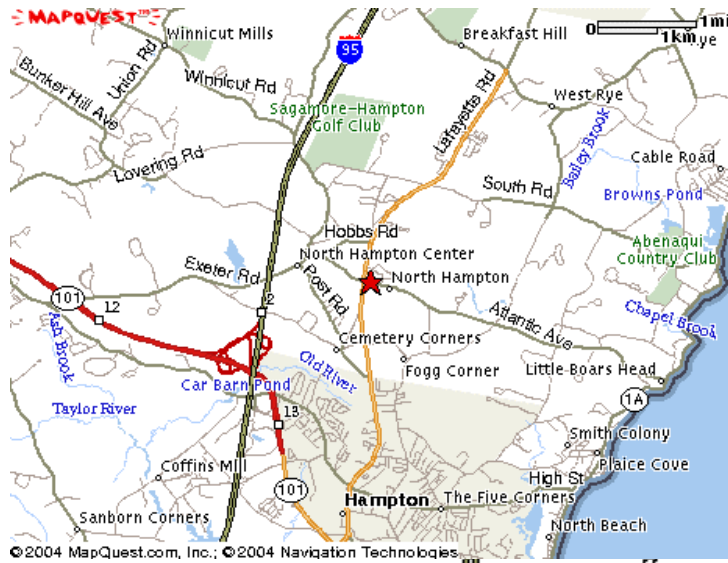

From NH 101 Eastbound: From Exit 12 on NH101, turn left at bottom of ramp onto NH 111 East. Follow to, and cross US 1 the signalized intersection. The Town Hall is located on the left side, just past the Library and Fire Station and before of the railroad overpass.

From U.S. Route 1: Turn east onto NH 111 (Atlantic Avenue) from U.S. 1 (at signalized intersection). The Town Hall is located on the left side, just past the Library and Fire Station and before of the railroad overpass.
