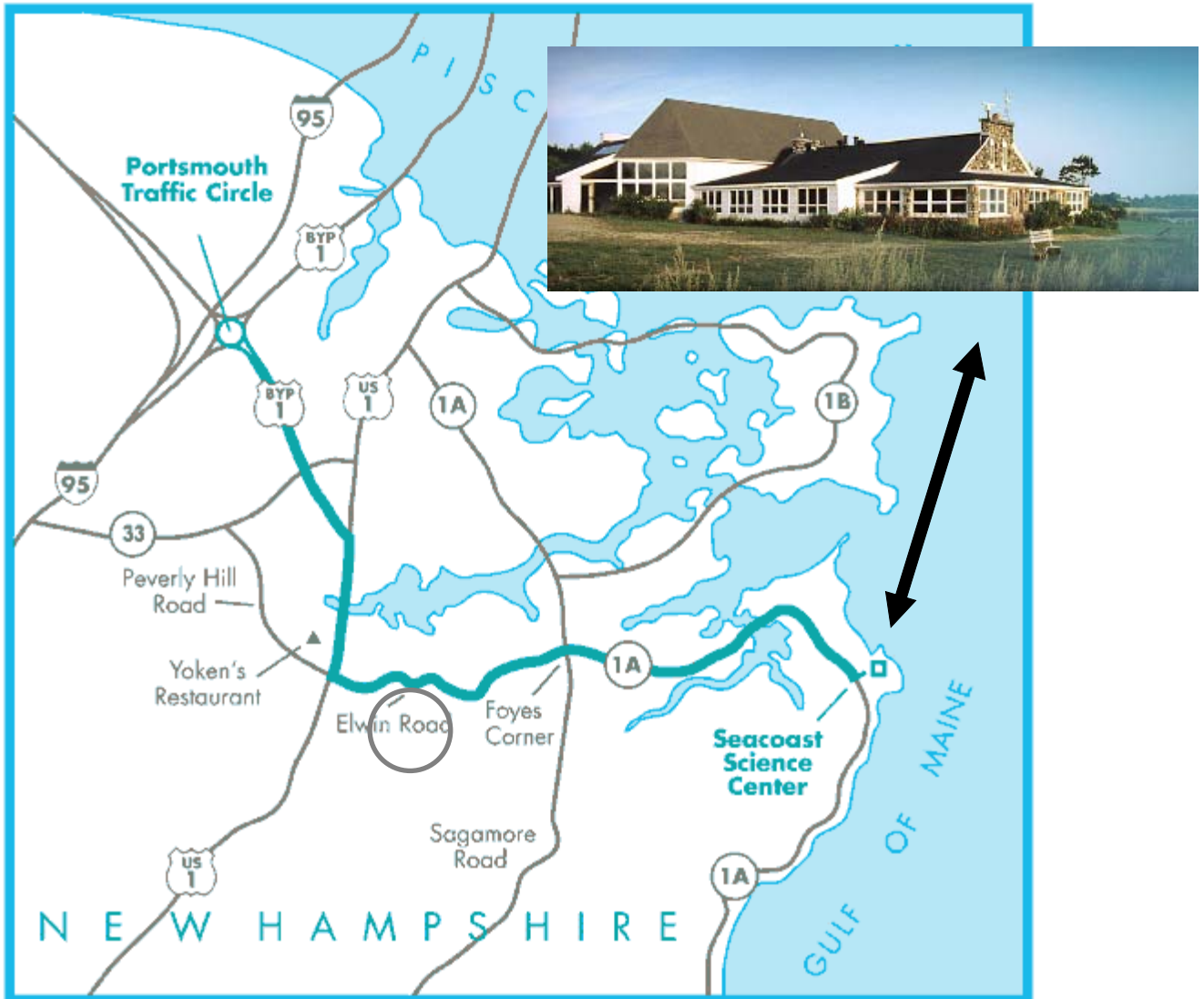

DIRECTIONS



From the Portsmouth Traffic Circle to the Seacoast Science Center:

Take Route 1 By-Pass South to Beaches/Hampton. After 1 mile the road connects with Route 1 South. Follow Route 1 South approximately 1 mile to the traffic light just past Yoken's Restaurant. Elwyn Road will be on the left. Turn left on Elwyn Road, go past the Urban Forestry Center (on your left), then go approximately 1.3 miles to the stop sign at Foyes Corner. Go straight at the stop sign onto Route 1A South. Continue for 1.8 miles, over the wood bridge at Seevey's Creek, past Odiorne boat launching ramp (on left), to the main entrance of Odiorne Point State Park (on left).
