

Notice of Public Comment Period & Public Hearing Coordinated Public Transit & Human Services Transportation Plan for Southeast New Hampshire

The Rockingham Planning Commission (RPC) and Strafford Regional Planning Commission (SRPC) have completed an update to the 2012 Coordinated Public Transit & Human Services Transportation Plan for the Southeast NH Regional Coordinating Council for Community Transportation (RCC). The RCC region covers 38 communities in Strafford, eastern Rockingham and southern Carroll Counties. The Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act requires development of this plan as a condition for access to funding under the Federal Transit Administration's Section 5310 program, designed to expand transportation access for senior citizens and individuals with disabilities.

The Coordinated Public Transit & Human Services Transportation Plan includes: 1) an assessment of transportation needs in the region; 2) an inventory of currently available transportation services; 3) strategies to address gaps in services; and 4) recommendations to expand access and improve efficiency through coordination.

The Public Comment period begins on **March 13, 2017** for thirty days. The public is encouraged to offer comments on the plan prior to the close of business (5:00 PM) on **April 12, 2017**. A public hearing is scheduled on Wednesday, April 12th, 7:00pm at the Regional Economic Development Center for Southeast NH (REDC), 57 Main Street, Raymond, NH.
