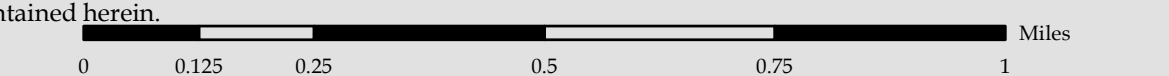
Unverified Protected Lands
