DIRECTIONS TO HAMPTON FALLS TOWN HALL

1 Drinkwater Rd., Hampton Falls NH

The Hampton Falls Town Hall is located at the intersection of Drinkwater Road and NH Route 88.

<u>From Route 1</u>: Turn west on NH 88 (Exeter Rd) at the center of Hampton Falls and proceed 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Drinkwater Road and immediately right into the Town Hall parking lot. <u>From Exeter</u>: From Town Center proceed east on High Street and turn onto NH Route 88. Proceed 4.8 miles and turn right onto Drinkwater Road and immediately right into the Town Hall parking lot.
